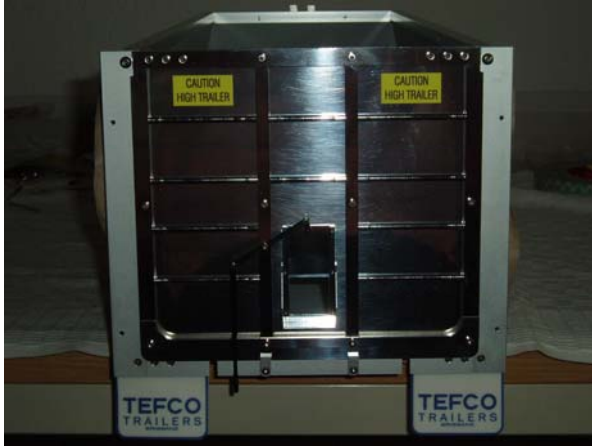
One of an interesting job was to design all decals for the trailers. The registration plate was easy to design because a girlfriend of mine had been in Australia for a few weeks and she took some photos of trucks and their registration plates. More work was to design the mud flaps because I could not read the last line on the mud flaps from the photos of your website and so I decided to call it BRISBANE. I don't know if this is correct!

The stickers are designed with AUTOCAD and printed with a colour laser printer on a transparent adhesive film.



Last but not least there are a few words and pictures from the production of the tippers. They are fully made of aluminium and then polished. The back of the tipper is made of about thirty parts and a mechanical system to bolt the back when the tipper is down. On the front side is a ladder like it is in original.
